**Packet Due date: First Day of School**

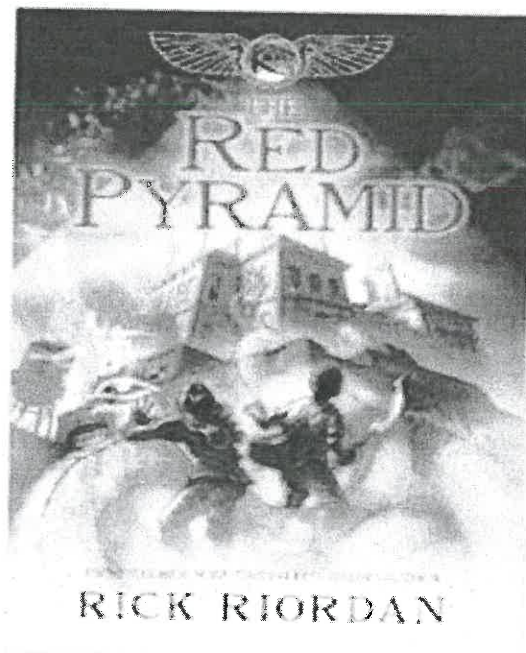
**Total packet points: 40**

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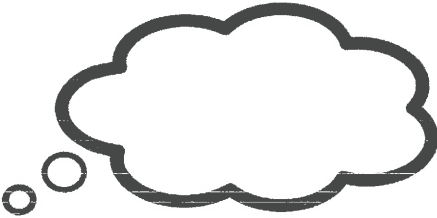
