COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

*Grades listed are for the 2019-2020 school year. All courses are offered in both sessions and are \$115 unless otherwise indicated. A \$20 materials fee is added to courses marked with "***".*

Acrylic Painting** *Grades: 3-8*

Session 2 only

Students will learn to paint still life and create outdoor scenes on canvas. Using basic painting skills and techniques, students will learn about the art of acrylics, brushes using canvas and real life to create your work. *Class seating is limited.*

All About Pets! *Grades: 1-8*

Session 2 only

Join one of our most popular classes from last summer! Students will have an opportunity to learn about responsible pet care including feeding, bathing and exercising pets. Students will have furry visitors to the classroom as well as take some walking field trips to learn some tips from local experts.

Students signing up for this class should be pet allergy free.

(Pre) Algebra Challenge *Grades: 5-7*

This class will reinforce algebraic skills for students, including CCCSS project-based learning. Students will be receiving some algebra instruction beyond simply CCCSS grade level math standards.

Algebra Skills *Grades: 7-8*

This class will emphasize skills needed to be successful in algebra. Students do not need previous algebra instruction in order to be in this class.

Baseball *Grades: 2-5*

Session 2 only

“Take me out to the ballgame...take me out to the crowd!” Join the coach as he teaches all students, beginning or proficient, the skills necessary to join your own team next spring. For this summer, join the St. Mary Summer School line up! ***Students should wear appropriate shoes and bring a glove.***

Basketball *Grades: 1-2, 2-4 (session 1); 1-2, 3-5, 6-8(session 2)*

This is a great class for all skill levels, especially if you are planning to play basketball during the school year. This class will emphasize skill development of fundamentals, including dribbling, passing, shooting and defense as well as basic play. Team strategy and court positioning will be introduced and practiced. This is a great way for you to improve your skills over the summer! **Students should wear comfortable clothes and athletic shoes.**

Beat Boyz! *Grades: 1-8*

Calling all boys! This fun class for boys will feature cool dance moves from hip hop, tap, step, jazz, and more! Students will be encouraged to use their creativity to come up with their own dance moves and choreography, while working as a team to put together a show for the whole school! We'll also learn to beatbox; making music with our mouths, hands, feet and objects to accompany our dance number! No dance experience required!

Beginning Reading Workshop *Grades 1-2*

Get a jump-start on your reading skills this summer! This seasoned First and Second Grade teacher knows just the tricks to help prepare you for next year.

Books and Cooks** *Grades: 1-4*

Session 1 only

Check out this fun class incorporating children's literature with cooking and art. Each class begins with a story and continues with a recipe and art project that will bring the story to life! Students will first read the stories together and enjoy class conversation. Then, you may have a chance to prepare spaghetti while reading *Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs* and experience art projects that coordinate with the concepts of the story. Various literature is used throughout the classes and students will leave this class with all the recipes from the course.

Candle Creations** *Grades: 2-8*

Session 2 only

Start out your summer making sweet smelling accessories for your home and friends. Pick your own scents, colors and designs when you make a variety of candles in this exciting class. Use different styles, techniques and molds to create unique treasures and gifts for yourself or family and friends.

Crochet** *Grades: 2-8*

Session 1 only

In this beginning class you will have fun learning the basic steps to crochet. Each student will receive a crochet hook, colored yarns and instructions. The students will choose their own small project to crochet like a scarf, small purse or perhaps a small pillow.

Dance Around the World *Grades: 1-8*

Students will learn techniques as they dance their way around the world! Novice and veteran dance students join us and learn a variety of dance genres, including: hip hop, jazz, ballet, tap, African, Irish, hula, modern/contemporary, ballroom, and Latin. Each class will introduce a new style through videos, music, a brief history and basic techniques.

Detective Academy *Grades: 1-4*

Do you love spy books? Mysteries? Are you interested in solving crimes? Playing detective games? Become a detective in this class and learn how to read fingerprints and other clues. Learn how to "crack the code". Become a super sleuth!

French Conversation *Grades: 4-8*

Session 2 only

Travel the French Riviera this summer with our three-week course in French language and culture. In this class, you will learn conversational French with basic grammar instruction. While learning to speak the language, explore the culture and the delicious cuisine!

Garage Band *Grades: 5-8*

Session 1 only

Students will learn the basics of how to record music in the Garage Band app on an Apple device. This includes how to use pre-made drum and instrumental loops, record quality live voice and instrument tracks, and also how to share their music with the world on various online platforms. Please bring your own Apple devices with the Garage Band app. (The app can be easily downloaded at the App store.) Students who do not have a device to bring can use a school mini iPad but would need to have the ability to email the music so they can work on the material at home.

Green Gardeners** *Grades: 1-8*

Session 1 only

Create your own flower boxes, plant veggies and herbs in the St. Mary School garden, learn about organic gardening and compost, make stepping-stones and even your very own terrarium in this favorite Summer School club. Learn about flower arrangements, keep a gardening journal and learn to propagate new plants. Students will be introduced to the world of plants through foods we eat and the "Farm to Fork" movement!

Guitar *Grades: 1-4, 4-8*

Session 1 only

Students will learn the basics about reading chord charts, TABS, and sheet music, as well as a song in each form. They will also learn how to find music online legally for themselves to enjoy once the class ends. They will also learn techniques to help strengthen their fingers and play more easily and fluidly. Please bring a guitar and it would be helpful to have a Capo, tuner and a metronome.

Hula Hooping** *Grades: 1-8*

Hooping: it's more than just trying to keep it around your waist! We'll learn a bunch of cool tricks with hula hoops, build core and arm strength, coordination, endurance, and musicality. Students will get their own hoop to decorate and take home to practice! Together we'll set our moves to music and put on a show for the school at the end of each session. No dance experience required! Both boys and girls are encouraged to participate!

Kids on the Move *Grades: 1-8*

Per session: \$60.00

(This class is a 1/2 hour in length) Early birds will begin each day at **8:00** with stretching and toning exercises. Following warm-up, boot campers will participate in various cardiovascular activities such as kickball, jogging, relays and obstacle course work. What a great way to wake up and get the blood flowing!

Kinder-Camp *Grades: Incoming Kindergarten*

Per session: \$475.00 (includes a.m. snack)

This all-day (**8:30am-2:25pm**) program will be offered to children starting Kindergarten in the fall. Kinder-Camp is open to students from other schools as well. Kinder-Camp provides an enriching environment in the St. Mary School Kindergarten classroom thus giving children a head start for the fall. Students will collaborate during lessons in literacy, math and center work. Students will participate in snack time while enjoying an opportunity to socialize with other kindergartners. Families may sign up for one or both sessions. This program includes a daily snack for your child, afternoon rest time and separate supervised recesses.

Kitchen Science** *Grades: 1-8*

"Snap, Crackle, Pop!" Have you ever wondered what it would be like to work in a real chemistry lab and experiment with chemical reactions? Many of the daily experiments in this class will be done with items that you have in your kitchen. Experience the wonders of chemistry unfolding right before your eyes...and mouth! After completing the class you can grab some items from the refrigerator or pantry and impress your family with your science skills.

Lego Engineers *Grades: 1-8*

Create, Play and Learn! Build a town, city, houses, buildings, bridges, tunnels, cars and so much more. Utilize Legos and Gears to create, build and play. Build motorized cars, trains, buses and trucks. Race them, crash them and repair them. Explore the possibilities in this fun class while exploring the concepts of physics, mechanical and structural engineering as well as architecture. Come and play with us!

Let the Games Begin! *Grades: 2-8*

Session 2 only

Join Coach Roybal for this fast paced recreation class and learn new skills while playing Sinkersball, Battleball, German Kickball as well as many new and old favorites.

Mad Math Facts! *Grades: 1-2*

California Common Core State Standards focuses on students in the 1st and 2nd grades mastering their math facts. This course provides the beginning foundation upon which all mathematics will develop over the course of 1st through 5th grades: the 4 operations and the 400 math facts. These are the bases for cognitive development, and all mathematical

applications through algebra and beyond. Students will have ample opportunity to practice math facts in a variety of different ways, utilizing various learning modalities.

Math Lab *Grades: 3-5 (Session 1 only); 5-6 (both sessions)*

Join a class designed to provide both remedial and enrichment skills to students. Using hands on learning, this math class will help to provide students with additional assistance with math computation and problem-solving skills. Students will be presented with a variety of techniques to help understand concepts and problem-solving skills through group, guided and individual instruction, math games and lots of practice time. Students will be given many opportunities to learn and practice California Common Core State Standards in math in an engaging and supportive environment.

Musical Theatre *Grades: 1-8*

Students will learn the elements of producing, rehearsing and performing a musical theatre production while learning songs and choreography for a number of musical theatre hits.

Number Ninjas *Grades: 2-3*

Session 2 only

Join this class and become a numbers warrior! Classes are designed to provide both remedial and enrichment skills to students. Number Ninjas will give students additional practice with math computation and problem-solving skills. Students will be presented with a variety of techniques to help understand concepts and problem-solving skills through group, guided and individual instruction, math games and plenty of practice time.

Ping Pong *Grades: 1-3 (session 2 only); 3-8 (both sessions)*

Ping pong is a fun, exciting way for families and friends to spend time together. People of all ages come together and play as it encourages social bonding, as well as mental and physical well-being. Ping pong players develop mental acuity, quick reflexes and excellent hand-eye coordination. In this class, students will learn basic rules of ping pong, how to serve, rally and use spin to improve their shots.

Positively Pinterest *Grades: 1-8*

Here's your chance to create inspiring, positive art this summer. Projects will be inspired by ideas found on Pinterest including such mediums as painting, collage, drawing, photography, and video. All students can bring in recyclables such as toilet paper rolls, paper plates, coffee filters and magazines. At the end of the session, students will host an Art Gallery for families and students to view all of the inspirational creativity!

Reader's Workshop *Grades: 2-4, 4-5, 6-8*

Classes are designed to provide students with additional support in comprehension, fluency, vocabulary, sequencing and writing skills. With a variety of activities to stimulate their interest in reading, students will have an opportunity to strengthen their skills in preparation for the fall. While reading to increase comprehension, fluency, and vocabulary, students will follow through with writing activities focused on improving techniques in sentence and paragraph formation. Students will practice locating text evidence and close reading.

Ready, Set, First Grade! *Grades: 1*

Are you ready? Set? Here comes first grade! This class was designed this year to reinforce the essential skills needed for first grade. Students will participate in activities that will give them an added boost for their first grade experience; these activities will include sequencing, narrating personal experiences and retelling a simple story with a beginning, middle and end. Other skills and activities will include recognizing rhymes and rhyming patterns, interacting within a group of classmates, sustaining attention/maintaining focus and listening/following directions. Ready? Set? Here we go!!

Science Rocks!** *Grades: 1-4, 4-8*

In this new course focused on integrating **STEM** into project-based learning, students explore Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) with hands-on engineering and science projects. Students will spend time working in teams to complete challenges. Prepare to get messy! **Spaces are limited and fill up fast!**

Sports Conditioning *Grades: 3-8*

Session 2 only

This course will consist of high intensity drills blending body weight and with aerobic activities to improve speed, agility, balance, and endurance. This class is best suited for ages 8 and up.

Soccer *Grades: 2-5*

Join Coach Poncini and strengthen your skills in passing, kicking, scoring and defending during relays and scrimmaging. Rules, team strategy and defense will also be introduced and practiced. This class is designed for all skill levels. Come prepared to work hard! ***Please bring soccer shoes, shin guards and a water bottle to class.***

Travel Writing *Grades: 4-5*

Session 1 only

In this course students will discover the genre of travel writing, an exciting and descriptive way to share adventures near and far. Whether students are describing a stay-cation or travels abroad, everyone can find a story to tell! Students will read examples from experts like in Lonely Planet guides as well as help peer edit each other's work. Through the course students will draft and perfect their travel stories as well as take notes, jot down ideas, and make edits in their travel journal. At the end of the course students will take home their travel journal full of inspiration.

Ukulele *Grades: 1-4, 4-6*

Session 1 only

Students will learn the basics about reading chord charts, TABS, and sheet music, as well as a song in each form. They will also learn how to find music online themselves legally to enjoy once the class ends. They will also learn techniques to help strengthen their fingers and play more easily and fluidly. If you have a Ukulele, you can bring it, otherwise we have them for use at school. It would also be helpful to have a Capo, tuner and a metronome.

Writer's Workshop *Grades: 2-4*

Writer's Workshop teaches concepts, strategies and techniques for writing while encouraging students to write in different genres or styles. Your teacher will provide direct instruction to students and model all lessons using authentic literature or teacher's writing. Writing Workshop helps young writers build confidence, take pride in work, develop creativity, improve literacy and increase the love of writing!
